What is the XXIV ICIS Biennial Congress?

The XXIV ICIS Biennial Congress **brings together researchers and practitioners from the many disciplines comprising the world of Infant Development.** ICIS is devoted to the promotion and dissemination of research on the development of infants around the globe.

The first ICIS Biennial Congress was held in the United States in 1978. The congress is committed to a global reach. We meet on different continents and welcome researchers and students from around the world.

Who is organizing the congress?

The **XXIV ICIS Biennial Congress** is being organized under the leadership of the ICIS President Rachel Barr (*Georgetown University*), incoming President Natasha Kirkham (*Birkbeck, University of London*) with support from the Board of Directors and multiple sub-committees.

The **Program Committee** is comprised of Sabine Seehagen (*Ruhr University Bochum*), Leher Singh (*National University of Singapore*) and Sam Wass (*University of East London*).

The overall **congress planning process** is organized by ICIS and the team at Podium Conference Specialists.

Who attends the congress?

The congress draws principal investigators, post-doctoral fellows and grad students actively engaged in infant development studies. Attendees include professionals and graduate students in psychology, human development, family studies, education, public policy, sociology, social work, psychiatry, pediatrics, public health, anthropology, speech pathology, and linguistics. Although the majority of delegates are based in the United States, a growing number of congress attendees are from other countries and regions such as Canada, the UK, Germany, France, Australia and Asia.
